

Pool Safety Policy.

BSC will draw to the attention of all its members to the Safety Policy and will ensure that they are familiar with and understand emergency procedures.

BSC try to be conscious of safety at all times to prevent accidents rather than having to deal with them afterwards.

BSC undertakes to agree with Pool Operators on the arrangements necessary for ensuring the safety of BSC swimmers at all times when pool hire occurs. The Sports Hall will provide lifeguard cover.

Before all Galas the safety rules and emergency procedures will be announced to all present. (ASA Guidelines sheet)

The Sports Hall management will provide adequate first aid facilities.

Members must be conversant with the fire and escape procedures displayed on the notice board. BSC will have fire practice at least twice a year.

In case of emergency, instructions will be broadcast over the speaker system. If the building needs to be evacuated BSC members will assemble on the grass to the front of the building. The senior coach at the session will call the register.

All accidents or incidents will require a report verbally immediately following the occurrence and in writing subsequently from those responsible for the group or event in progress at the time of such accident/incident. The written report must be submitted to the club secretary and the details entered in the appropriate accident logbook located in BSC cupboard.

The club will receive and update the Safety Policy document as and when required by new circumstances.
